THE LOGO

The College council, at its meeting held on the 21st December 1950, decided that the college should have a Coat of Arms of its own. The following design was adopted.

There is a shield with a Konark wheel on the left, and a boat on the high seas on the right with a motto beneath that reads "Dharama Saranam Gachhami".

The motto is the second of the three Buddhist vows Fakir

Mohan Senapati chose as the guiding principle of his life.

The boat on the seas symbolizes the maritime glories of Odisha in which Balasore played no small part. The colours of the Coat of Arms are gold in the first quarter, Silver in the 2nd and 3rd quarters and azure in the 4th quarter.
